Ein newyddion mawr ni o ran y Llywodraeth ydy ein bod wedi derbyn trwydded i weithredu fel ysgol gynradd swyddogol. Bydd hyn yn sicrhau bod y plant yn gallu dilyn eu haddysg gynradd ffurfiol gyda ni yn Ysgol y Cwm.

Dear friends,

Here we are greeting you on a fine autumnal day in the Andes with the sound of children's voices in the background. We are now in May and two months of activities have taken place. By now more than 60 children have registered for the nursery and Year 1. The building work is coming along nicely, with lots of work having been done over the summer holidays. The classrooms and the hallway have been painted, the toilets and bathrooms have been completed and outside the eaves have been completed and the pupils are playing happily on the playground equipment that was donated by the Chubut Lottery.

Work is underway to level the ground behind the school, where foundations will be set for a school hall which will hopefully also be able to host the Trevelin Eisteddfod, which this year celebrates 40 years since it was revived. The school staff continues to grow with the arrival of our new Year 1 Spanish teacher, Claudia Mazziotti. Working alongside her and in the nursery school we are very pleased to welcome back Nia Jones, and we also welcome Mared Gruffydd who has come to volunteer with us for three months. Our big news is that the government has awarded us status as an official primary school – this will ensure that the pupils can complete all their formal primary education here at Ysgol y Cwm.

We held a Noson Lawen in the company of Tecwyn Ifan in March, during which time he and his wife Rhiannon were here leading folk singing and cerdd dant workshops. We had a fabulous evening with a variety of contributions from pupils and friends in the community.

A drama group called 'Sonrisas

Nomadas' came to entertain us in April. The three group members have been travelling around the world in an old fire engine so this was a unique experience and everyone enjoyed themselves! One of the highlights of the year is the Trevelin Eisteddfod as we welcome friends from the Chubut Valley and from Wales to enjoy three days of competition. As always the competitions were of a high standard and plenty of our pupils came back to school with prizes. After the Cymanfa Ganu in Capel Bethel we had a feast – a pata flambeada, which is a whole flaming beef leg and we raised enough money to be able to face another month of bills!

Maybe some of you have heard about the terrible floods which happened in the southern Chubut city of Comodoro Rivadavia and that people are homeless because of the awful destruction. They had no water for three weeks and so we got together and collected bottled water and non-perishable goods to send to the communities hardest hit – an example of the community spirit of the school.

Gwion has been working very hard to create a short video about the school and our hopes for the future. In 2018 we would like to employ a teacher from Wales – perhaps you know of someone who might like to come and work with us for a year? In order to pay for the teacher, we're looking for 150 people to donate £5 a month through a standing order.
